

1. Balvatika Teacher

1.1 Mandatory Qualifications.

1.1.1. Senior Secondary or its equivalent with at least 50 percent marks from a recognised board.

1.1.2. Diploma in Nursery Teacher Education Pre-School Education/ Early Childhood Education Programme (D.E.C.Ed. or NTT) of a duration not less than two years.

OR

B.Ed. Nursery from an NCTE recognised institution.

Note:-

I. While candidates with higher qualifications may apply, preference is to be given to candidates with qualifications mentioned in above Para 1.1.2

II. In case candidate with Two years D.E.C.Ed. or NTT is not available, then candidates same with one year diploma in D.E.C.Ed. or NTT may be appointed.

1.1.3. Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

1.1.4. Candidates with at least two years' continuous service as a PGT/ TGT/ PRT/ or three years as NTT/ Balvatika Teacher in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

1.1.5 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years in upper age limit.

1.1.6 Ex-servicemen candidates holding a valid ex serviceman card/ Certificate of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit, provided they should have at least three years of residual service as on 01 Jul of the Academic year in which they are being considered for the post. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

1.1.7. Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

1.2. Desirable Qualifications (Due weightage to be given during selection).

1.2.1. Basic knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

1.2.2. Should be able to read/ write/ communicate in Hindi.

1.2.3. Experience in art, craft, cartoon, caricature, puppet making, music, dance etc.

1. Headmaster/ Headmistress Primary School

1.1. Mandatory Qualifications.

1.1.1. **Academic Qualification.** Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50 percent marks from any Govt recognised institution/ Board.

OR

Graduate Degree with an aggregate of 50 percent from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE.

1.1.2. **Professional Qualification.** 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known) from a recognized board.

OR

4-year Bachelor in Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.)

OR

2-year Diploma in Education (Special Education) from Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI)*

The candidate with D.Ed. (Special Education) qualification must have completed an NCTE recognised 6- months Special Programme in Elementary Education.

2.2. **Experience.** Teaching experience of at least two years as a PRT/ NTT/ Balvatika Teacher in a recognised school or experience of at least two years as Principal/ HM in a recognised School.

2.2.1. Age.

2.2.1.1. Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled. There will be no upper age limit in the case of serving staff of Air Force Schools but they should have at least two years of residual service as on 01 July of the academic year in which they are being considered for the post.

2.2.1.2. Candidates with at least three years as a PRT or Balvatika Teacher in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force Schools. Such Age relaxation would be upto a maximum of eight years.

2.2.1.3. Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a HM in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School will be given age relaxation up to the extent of such service rendered in Air Force Schools. Such Age relaxation would be upto a maximum of eight years.

2.2.1.4 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years in upper age limit.

2.2.1.5 Ex-servicemen candidates holding a valid ex serviceman card/ Certificate of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit, provided they should have at least three years of residual service as on 01 Jul of the Academic year in which they are being considered for the post. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

2.3. **Language.** Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

2.4. **Desirable Qualifications (Due weightage to be given during selection).**

2.4.1. Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

2.4.2 Conversant with POCSO Act, CBSE rules, NCERT, POSH Act, JJ Act, NEP, NCrf 2023 etc.

2.4.3. Attended educational workshops.

2.4.4 Ability to read/ write/ communicate in Hindi.

2.4.5. CTET/ STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

1. Lab Attendant (Computer)

1.1 Mandatory Qualifications:

1.1.1 Academic Qualifications. 10+2 with Physics and Maths.

1.1.2 Professional Qualification. Certificate / Diploma in Basic Computer Knowledge/ Computer Hardware/ Computer Networking/ Computer Maintenance or any other higher computer/ IT qualification of minimum one year duration from a Govt recognized institute.

1.2 Age between 21 to 50 yrs as on 01 Jul of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

1.2.1 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years in upper age limit.

Ex-servicemen candidates holding a valid ex serviceman card/ Certificate of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit, provided they should have at least three years of residual service as on 01 Jul of the Academic year in which they are being considered for the post. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

1.3 Should be able to read, write and Communicate fluently in English or Hindi.

1.4 Desirable Qualifications (Due weightage to be given during selection)

1. Post Graduate Teachers

1.1 Mandatory Qualifications

1.2 A Masters Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum aggregate marks of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate:

OR

Integrated Post-Graduate course from NCTE recognise Institution/ university, in the concerned subject (refer table below) with at least 50 percent marks in aggregate including B.Ed. component (with 50 percent marks):

1.2.1 PGT (History) : History

1.2.2 PGT (Entrepreneurship Development): Entrepreneurship (Masters in Entrepreneurship/ Masters in Commerce from a recognized University/ institute)

1.3 A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

OR

Three years integrated B.Ed.- M.Ed from NCTE recognise institute/ university with atleast 50 percent marks.

OR

Four years integrated degree with at least 50 percent marks from NCTE recognised Institution/ university including B.ED. Component.

1.4 Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

1.5 Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT/Balvatika Teacher in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School will be given age relaxation up to the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

1.5.1 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years in upper age limit.

1.5.2 Ex-servicemen candidates holding a valid ex serviceman card/ Certificate of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit, provided they should have at least three years of residual service as on 01 Jul of the Academic year in which they are being considered for

the post. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

1.5.3 Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English (except PGT Hindi).

1.6 Desirable Qualifications (Due weightage to be given during selection).

1.6.1 Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

1.6.2 Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

1.6.3 CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

1. Trained Graduate Teachers.

1.1. Mandatory Qualifications.

1.1.1. Four years integrated degree course from NCTE recognised institution/ university with at least 50 percent marks in the concerned subject(s) as well as in the aggregate including B. Ed. component (with 50 percent marks).

OR

Post-Graduation in concerned subject/any specialisation in concerned subject with a minimum of 55% marks or equivalent grade provided that the candidate has studied the subject(s) mentioned below at the graduation level.

OR

Bachelor Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in the concerned subject and 50 percent in the aggregate.

1.1.2. Electives Subjects and languages. The candidates must have studied following elective subjects/ languages in the combination of subjects as given under at graduation level:-

TGT (English)	:	English as an elective/ main subject at Degree level
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1.1.3 A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/ AICTE/ UGC/ National Council of Teachers Education.

OR

Three years integrated B. Ed.- M. Ed. From NCTE recognised Institution/ University with at least 50 percent marks.

OR

Four years Integrated Degree with at least 50 percent marks from NCTE recognised Institution/ University including B.ED. component.

1.1.4 Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

1.1.5 Candidates with at least two years' continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT/Balvatika Teacher in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School. Such age relaxation would be upto a maximum of eight years.

1.1.6 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years in upper age limit.

1.1.7 Ex-servicemen candidates holding a valid ex serviceman card/ Certificate of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not

exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit, provided they should have at least three years of residual service as on 01 Jul of the Academic year in which they are being considered for the post. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

1.1.8 Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English (except TGT Hindi, Sanskrit, Games and Drawing).

1.2.2. Ability to read/ write/ communicate in Hindi.
